Transport to and from the Cape is provided, as is food for the duration. Handy painters, who also enjoy a bit of time slaving over a hot stove, are also welcome, says Dene.

"We know it's the sort of place people love to get to, and the team who painted the exterior of the hut last year enjoyed the chance to get out there."
